MANUFACTURING INFORMATION

- American Biltrite Inc. (ABI) has been ISO 9001:2008 registered since 1993.
 - ABI meets or exceeds all state and federal regulations.
 - ABI recycles 165,000 pounds of waste on an average monthly basis.
 - ABI implements packaging conservation & reciprocal recycling programs on an individual account basis.
- Majority of adhesive coating is water-based
- Solvent coating technologies enable high solids/low solvent content
- Two solvent coating lines use a solvent recovery system
 - Recycled recovery solvent is reused internally
- R&D continues to develop non-solvent alternatives for existing products
- ABI operates a 12 acre parcel of vacant land for a corn farm, which is ultimately used for animal feed.

PRODUCT INFORMATION

ABI paper products are made of 85% natural ingredients including cellulose, latex and rosin esters.

The paper backings used for TransferRite® application tapes are manufactured from renewable resources by a company that considers environmental stewardship to be a core value.

All cellulose fiber is sourced responsibly and sustainably from managed forests. All of the fiber is declared Elemental Chlorine Free by those vendors.

The supplier manages its effluent streams to meet or exceed all local, state and federal requirements.
